Campground Enhancing- Ongoing work with water runoff, roads, and sidewalks; priorities are being set for 2018 improvements


Fall Report

Development Update

This fall we have been working to tie up a few loose ends with the previous stage of our development as well as doing small landscaping projects to enhance what we already have. Very thankfully, we have also received an additional \$30,000 to go toward our dining hall infrastructure. This brings us to a total of \$97,000 raised toward the \$250,000 need.

Every fall we offer churches the opportunity to reserve a place for camp the next summer through our Fast Track program. This gives us an idea of what to expect and helps us balance our weeks. With two youth camps scheduled for 2018, we have already closed one to any additional groups. The second youth camp and junior camp have also had good initial interest.

To prepare for these camps, we have been working hard to recruit summer staff counselors, Ranch Hands, and operational staff. We have filled many positions, but we are still in need of several additional young people to help out next summer.

We currently need four additional counselors and two Ranch Hands. We may possibly need two other program or operational staff workers in specific areas. Please pray with us that the Lord will send us exactly who He would have work with us next summer and that all our staff needs would be met.

We are also busy preparing for our spring events. In addition to our annual Southwest Regional Men on the Move Conference in March and our Ladies Spring Getaway in April, we are also developing Senior Trip Retreats to accommodate Christian schools from around the country.
