Development Projects Needing Funds and/or Workers

- * Sanitation system installation *\$30,000 of \$275,000 raised*
- * Electrical distribution hookup *God has provided an electrician to guide us in the process. We are working now to determine costs involved.*
- * Development of the activity facilities *We plan to seal our basketball court, build a softball backstop, and put up a roof over one set of bleachers.*
- * Completion of the interior of the cabins and first aid buildings *The money is raised; some workers are helping this fall, and we need additional workers in the spring.*
- * Temporary auditorium expansion *\$500 of \$1,500 is raised. Work is beginning this fall. Workers are needed in the spring to complete the project.*
- * Road extension *\$4,500 needed to install one spur for fire protection and enhancing the camp.*
